HANNAH RECEIVES FIRST SECURITY PROFESSIONAL AWARD

'MOST DESERVING" TAKES 2000 TROPHY

Larry Hannah became the first in our community to receive the Kansas City ASIS Security Professional Award for 2000. The award, which is the result of more than a year of planning, is a way for the Kansas City Chapter to recognize the outstanding efforts of one of our colleagues in the security industry who has contributed to the profession and the community. Chapter Chairman Chris Storms presented the award to Hannah at the monthly meeting February 3 at the Hereford House before about 80 members.

Storms described Hannah's contributions professional achievements which led to his selection. Storms said that Hannah "is always willing to give his time and talents in order to better the security industry. He spent many hours working for the Chapter as chairman, and organized the chapter committees and files better than they have ever been organized.
